

***Bufort B. and Sudie K. McKelvey Scholarship Fund Regulations***  
***Easley First United Methodist Church***

1. This scholarship will be awarded annually. Pickens County high school seniors who wish to pursue a course of study leading to a degree in an accredited four year college or university may apply. Any Easley First United Methodist Church member who is a high school senior at accredited school or home school program or any current student at an accredited four year college or university may also apply and be considered for the scholarship.
2. Considerations for student selection are:
  - a. financial need
  - b. academic ability for college work
  - c. outstanding character
  - d. potential to develop into a good citizen
3. Scholarship monies will be paid directly to the college in August.
4. Scholarship funds may be used only for tuition, fees, room and board, books, and supplies. Cash will not be paid to the student.
5. A scholarship recipient who fails to enroll in college in the academic year of his or her award will normally forfeit the scholarship. One who withdraws from college and does not transfer to another accredited institution will normally forfeit the unused portion of his or her award.
6. A student may reapply annually for subsequent years. A report of progress and grades earned, such as a transcript, is required with subsequent applications.
